Major Activities done by Team of Lok Prerna --

1, LOK PRERNA has been implemented Watershed Development Programme under IWMP special Project NB-RIDF in Jamtara District Jharkhand for 52 villages of Fatehpur and NalaBlock, Jharkhand State Watershed Mission is nodal agency under Ministry of Rural Development, Government of Jharkhand approved the annual action plan for implementation of following activities in the target area - Construction of 5 Farm Pond (100x100x10) 29 Dova (small pond -60x60x10), 494 Loose Boulder Structures, 132 Hectare Trench - cum - Bunds, 22 Hectare Water Absorption Tanks, 5 Check dams earthen and 5 CCD and various capacity development programmes with some viable agriculture demonstration for Oilseed, pulses and vegetable cultivation.

The Jharkhand State Watershed Mission, serving as the nodal agency under the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of Jharkhand, has played a pivotal role in approving the annual action plan for the project. This plan outlines a comprehensive set of activities aimed at sustainable development in the targeted area.

Construction of 5 Farm Ponds (100x100x10):



The project has successfully constructed five farm ponds with dimensions of 100x100x10. These farm ponds serve as essential water reservoirs, aiding in rainwater harvesting and providing a sustainable water source for agricultural activities in the region.

29 Dova (Small Pond - 60x60x10):

Alongside the larger farm ponds, 29 smaller ponds, known as Dova, have been constructed with dimensions of 60x60x10. These smaller water bodies contribute to localized water storage and distribution, promoting efficient water use in agriculture.

494 Loose Boulder Structures:

The implementation includes the construction of 494 loose boulder structures. These structures play a crucial role in soil conservation, preventing erosion and promoting a healthier environment for agriculture.

132 Hectare Trench-cum-Bunds:

Trench-cum-bunds covering 132 hectares have been strategically implemented to conserve soil and water, contributing to improved moisture retention and reduced soil erosion in the agricultural landscape.





22 Hectare Water Absorption Tanks:

Water absorption tanks covering 22 hectares have been established, enhancing the groundwater recharge mechanism and supporting sustainable water availability in the region.

5 Check Dams (Earthen) and 5 CCD:

Contour Trenches (CCD) has been completed. These structures help in regulating water flow, preventing soil erosion, and facilitating groundwater recharge.

Capacity Development Programmes:

In addition to physical infrastructure, the project has incorporated various capacity development programs. These programs aim to empower local communities with the knowledge and skills required for effective watershed management, sustainable agriculture, and overall rural development.

Viable Agriculture Demonstrations:

The project includes demonstrations for viable agriculture practices, with a focus on oilseed, pulses, and



vegetable cultivation. These demonstrations serve as practical models for local farmers, promoting diversified and sustainable farming methods.

Reproductive Health Incompatibility, an area of health concern that requires precise knowledge and effective communication strategies. **LOK PRERNA** collaborated with health authorities and professionals to design a comprehensive curriculum tailored to the specific needs and challenges prevalent in the region.
